

BBQ At The Quarry

Cook-Off Rules

Friday July 1st & Saturday July 2nd 2016

1. The decisions of the BBQ at the Quarry Committee are final.
2. Each team will consist of a head cook and as many assistants as the chief cook permits.
3. Each team will be assigned a 20x20ft space.
4. Cookers, grills, props, tents or any other equipment may not exceed the boundaries of the assigned area.
5. Contestants must provide all equipment.
6. Water will be available at a fixed location.
7. No open pits or holes.
8. It is the responsibility of the contestants to see that their assigned area is kept clean during and after the event.
9. All wood and charcoal products should be extinguished and deposited in the assigned area. All equipment must be removed and trash placed in the dumpster.
10. No refund of sign-up fees.
11. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages, foul, abusive or unacceptable language, or excessive noise by a team, member, or guest may result in the disqualification of a team.
12. Fires must be of wood, pellets, or charcoal. No electric or gas grills permitted. Propane may only be used as a fire starter.
13. Contestants must adhere to all electric, fire, and other city, county, state, and federal codes.
14. First aid will not be provided.
15. NO cooking or meat prep may begin until the Official Meat Inspector has inspected meat.
16. Once meat has been inspected, it must not leave the contest site.
17. No use of tobacco products will be allowed while handling meat.
18. Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times.
19. Sanitary gloves are required for food prep.
20. Each team's work area is expected to be kept clean at all times. Sanitizing of the area should be done with bleach water (1/2 cap to a gallon). Each team should provide a separate container for washing, rinsing, and sanitizing of the utensils.
21. Cook's meeting is Friday at 6:45 pm.
22. Use of gas or other auxiliary heat sources inside the pit will result in immediate disqualification.
23. Meat must start out raw. No pre-seasoned meats will be allowed.
24. Event organizers will provide turn-in containers.
