

Limestone Trail and Streetscape Construction

Project Description:

This project consists of construction of streetscape improvements and trail facilities within the general vicinity of the Lawrence County Courthouse in the City of Bedford. This project is a continuation of the Stellar Community Grant Projects in the spirit of the recently completed Courthouse Grounds and Harp Commons projects and the Depot Relocation project that is currently nearing completion.

The project limits consist of the Courthouse Square "out blocks" of 15th Street, I Street, 16th Street, and J Street. It also includes J Street from 17th Street to 14th Street and 14th Street from J Street north to the mid-block.

This project consists of reconstruction of the existing sidewalks/pedestrian areas to install new storm sewer facilities, sidewalks, pavers, curbs and gutters, retaining walls, railings, landscaping, signage, pavement markings, roadway lighting, and pedestrian signal upgrades at the four corners of the Courthouse Square.

Please note that limited access will be available at all times for both vehicular and pedestrian traffic throughout the duration of the contract. We thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation while this project to further enhance the City of Bedford is completed.
