Photography Contest

Friday, June 23 and Saturday, June 24 in the meeting room of the Lawrence County Museum. Entries will be accepted from 4-8 p.m. on Thursday, June 22. The show will be open from noon until 8 p.m. on Friday and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday.

This is a judged contest and the public will have an opportunity to vote on their favorite as well. A \$5 entry fee for each photograph will be charged and awards will be given for first, second and third places in each of the three categories:

Limestone in Nature, Limestone in Architecture and General Limestone. The People's Choice winner will receive a \$100 prize.

New this year will be a Youth Division for those under the age of 16. They will compete in the same three categories as the adults and the same ribbons will be awarded. The People's Choice winner in the Youth Division will win a \$50 prize.

There will be a sub-category of Limestone in Architecture in the Downtown Area. The area includes anything within 3 blocks of the downtown square, from 12th Street on the north to 19th Street in the south, from F Street in the east to M Street on the west. Those entering this category, both adult and youth, give permission for Bedford Revitalization, Inc. (BRI) to use their photographs in the publication of a 2024 calendar.

- Photos should be mounted but can be framed if you choose
- Images should be at least a 5x7 print and no larger than 11x14
- Images should be single frame / not composite or heavily modified
